Wonder Imagine Make (WIM)

Time allocation: Equivalent to 1 hr hour per week -

Rationale: Libraries in the 21st Century are evolving as places to wonder, imagine and make. With this in mind the library has been moved into a room and has learning spaces set up to foster wonderings, imagining and making.

Purpose: To develop and inspire students to imagine, wonder and make. This is also to provide connectivity.

Guidelines for implementation:

- 1. Each class has a one hour session each week.
- 2. The centre is open from 8:30am before school and during each lunchtime from 1:50 until 2:15pm.
- 3. Students are encouraged and expected to borrow and return books.
- 4. Activities are available for students on a rotational basis and in some instances, interest basis.
- 5. Leveraging Technology and connecting to books where possible.
- 6. Activities provided to facilitate collaboration between students are in the rotations.
- 7. Making activities, which can be art or technology inspired, are included.
- 8. Coding activities involving Beebots, Probots, Makey Makeys and Little Bits are available.
- 9. Research strategies and methods along with eSmart safety are taught in lessons.
